Conditions of use for SMMC 1

1. The frequency may only be used:
 - a. For genuine testing.
 - b. On events where SMMC has granted authorisation for its use on the specified dates. This can be obtained by email from radio.events@smmc.org.uk.
2. The frequency may only be used (including testing) within the licensed area (Scotland and OS Grid NT, NU, NY and the northern half of SD).
3. The frequency may only be installed on MSA licensed radios.
4. SMMC 1 will be operated as a controlled network. MSA guidance on the use of radio should be followed at all times. Only trained operators should be permitted to use the frequency without supervision.
5. In addition to MSA licensing requirements the MSA license holder must notify SMMC of the following details each year by 31st May:
 - a. Name
 - b. Address
 - c. email address
 - d. phone number
 - e. MSA callsign
 - f. MSA ANI
 - g. Make/Model/Serial No of radio
 - h. Copy of the last certificate of conformance from an MSA registered radio supplier.

This information should be submitted at <http://smmc.org.uk/radioreg.aspx>
6. Registration of the information in item 5 confers authority to use SMMC1, subject to these terms until 31st May of the following year.
7. The frequency may only be used on registered radios.
8. Registration confers authorisation for SMMC to share a list of callsigns and ANIs with event organisers and radio operators. No personal information will be shared.
9. Radio configuration should conform to SMMC's technical requirements (provided to MSA registered radio engineers).
10. SMMC retain the right to refuse use of the frequency, and to request its removal from radios at the owner's expense
